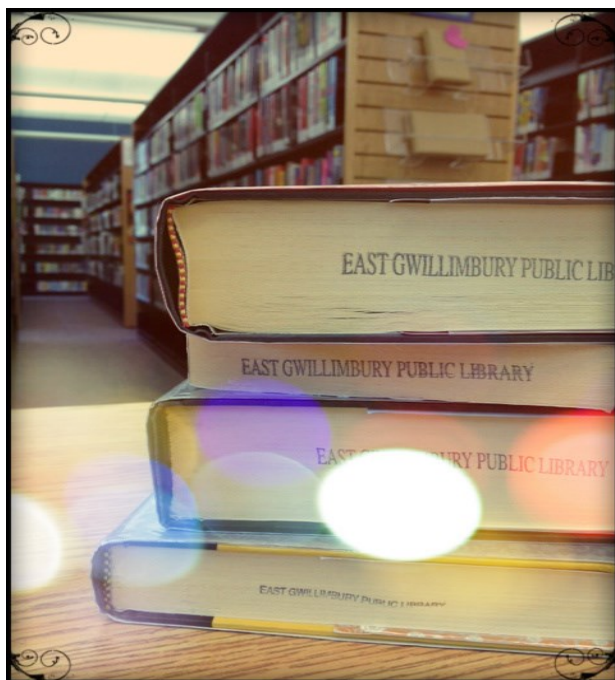

The *Public Libraries Act* requires Board Members be:

- At least 18 years of age
- A Canadian citizen
- A resident of the Town of East Gwillimbury
- Not employed by the Library or the Municipality
