#### **SUMMARY**

Under the direction of a designated supervisor, provides support for the TD Summer Reading Club.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 1. Support participants during SRC programming to record reading hours.
- 2. Good attendance and punctuality are required.
- 3. Foster an encouraging and positive environment for program participants.
- 4. Support staff in recording hours of Summer Reading Club participants
- 5. Supports the Mission, Vision and Values of the East Gwillimbury Public Libraries.
- 6. Responsible for following Health & Safety policies and procedures.
- 7. Record hours worked and tasks accomplished if required for community service placements.
- 8. Other duties as assigned.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS**

- Completed Grade 8.
- Proficiency in English language.
- Demonstrated interest and enthusiasm in working with children and the public.
- Ability to communicate courteously and effectively.
- Patient, dependable and reliable.
- Volunteers must be under 18 and complete a defense declaration form.

## TIME COMMITMENT

- Volunteers must commit to a minimum participation level of 2 hours per week as scheduled for the duration of the program (excluding holidays).
- Availability Tuesday to Saturday during the morning, afternoon or evening.
- Volunteers must complete and submit a Summer Reading Club Volunteer application.

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Volunteers must complete and submit a Summer Reading Club Volunteer application.

#### **TRAINING**

Volunteers must attend an orientation/training session prior to participating in the program.

#### **BENEFITS**

- Volunteers will gain valuable work experience and develop teamwork and leadership skills.
- Volunteers will earn community service hours for their secondary school diploma.
